CULTURED VS. FARM-RAISED MEATS

Debates pitting environmental benefits from cultured meat against farm-raised livestock may overlook the higher carbon emissions some cultured-meat processes generate, a recent study warns.

General reliance on carbon-based fuels means all meat production systems produce potentially harmful greenhouse gases.

But the most energy-intensive of the four cultured-meat systems in the Oxford University study are likely to emit higher levels of carbon dioxide (CO₂) than livestock production, physicists John Lynch and Raymond Pierrehumbert concluded

from their research.

While cattle emissions include CO₂, they also include nitrous oxide and methane. The latter gases, which are animal digestion byproducts, dissipate more quickly in the atmosphere than CO₂.

“Our current ‘carbon footprints’ don’t do a very good job of recognizing that CO₂ emissions stick around in the atmosphere for a very long time, while methane emissions don’t,” Lynch added in an email statement.

As a result, “cultured meat is not prima facie climatically superior to cattle,” the scientists concluded in their February journal article.

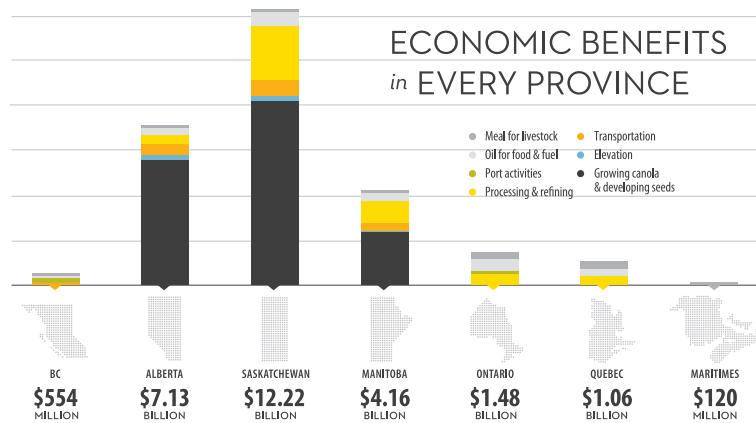

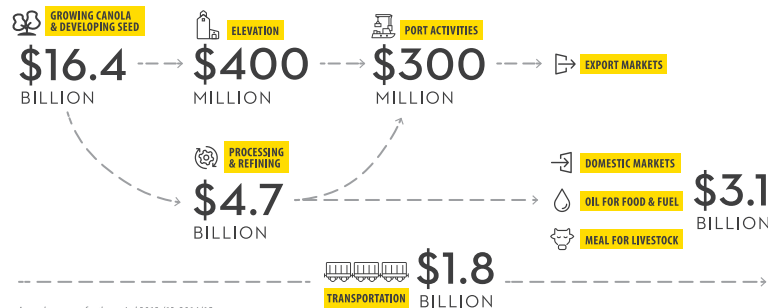
